

English, Communication and Language

- Children will use a variety of text drivers to create setting descriptions and a police crime report.
- Children will write a letter to a personal trainer, detailing the results of their pulse rate experiment.
- Children will use the text driver "The Island" to write a newspaper article about a stranger who arrived one day.
- In French, the children will be learning how to speak French again: learning numbers up to 31; speaking and writing basic phrases.

Mathematical understanding

- Children will be revising topics from last year such as place value and addition and subtraction; they will be introduced to decimals and percentages whilst learning various reasoning techniques especially how to explain their answers.

Historical, Geographical and Social Understanding

- Children will research a scientist from the past and write a biography about them. They will be able to explain their importance upon science and medicine today.
- In PSHE the children will look at health and wellbeing including mental health and how images online and social media can be distorted and misleading

Healthy Me

Understanding Physical Development, Health and Wellbeing

- Children will learn about the importance of exercise, what happens to our pulse rate when we exercise, and why this happens. An experiment will be conducted on this.

Understanding the Arts

- Children will use sketching pencils to carry out observation drawings of the human skeleton.

Computing and ICT

- Children will consolidate their understanding of how to stay safe online and how to create, write and contribute to a blog about a health lifestyle.

- Children will learn about the bones, key organs, muscles, joints, and how the digestive system works.
